Dear Cora

The Legal Practitioners Admission Board of the Northern Territory considered your email dated 6 December 2019 at its meeting held 18 February 2020.

The Board agreed in principle with the initiative to remove the word "fame" from the Legal Profession Admission Rules 2015. The Board however considers that it is preferable to maintain uniformity in all jurisdictions in respect of provisions relating to admission of legal practitioners. The Board was of the view that such a change should only be made once all jurisdictions agreed to adopt the change and if it were made contemporaneously with a corresponding change in all Australian jurisdictions so that uniformity with admission rules in all jurisdictions is maintained.
